

RESULT OF BREAST CANCER SCREENING

Your screening result is normal.

Nothing indicative of breast cancer was detected in your mammograms.

THE RESULT SHOWS THE CURRENT SITUATION

There is no need to x-ray symptomless breasts more often than once every two years. However, normal vigilance is advisable because breast cancer may appear before the next screening session. Consult a doctor if you notice changes in your breasts (e.g. a lump, hardening, discharge, retraction of the breast or nipple).

NEXT INVITATION

You will receive the next invitation to breast cancer screening in about two years. All women between 50 and 69 years of age are invited for screening every two years.
